

ACCEPTED PROOFS OF RESIDENCE

ID WITH VOTER CURRENT NAME/ADDRESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid Minnesota driver's license, Minnesota learner's permit, or Minnesota ID card. • The yellow receipt for a Minnesota driver's license, Minnesota learner's permit or Minnesota ID card. • Tribal ID card with name, current address, signature, and picture issued by the tribal government of a tribe recognized by the Bureau of Indian Affairs. Tribal band members are not required to live on an Indian reservation to use the tribal ID to prove residence.
Photo ID plus document with name and current address	<p>ONE OF THE FOLLOWING APPROVED ID'S....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • US passport • US Military ID card • Tribal ID card with name, signature and photo of the voter • Minnesota university, college, or technical ID card <p>Minnesota High School ID card</p>
VOUCHER	<p>AND ONE OF THE FOLLOWING APPROVED DOCUMENTS....</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Residential lease or rental agreement (Valid through Election Day) • Current student fee statement • Bill, account or start of service statement due or dated within 30 days of election for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Phone (landline, cell, VOIP, etc...) ○ TV (cable, satellite, etc.) ○ Internet services ○ Solid waste or sewer services ○ Electric, gas, or water ○ Banking or credit card ○ Rent or mortgage payments
COLLEGE STUDENT ID	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • College ID containing a photo can be used along with a housing list provided by the College
VALID REGISTRATION IN THE SAME PRECINCT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If voter is currently registered in the precinct, but changed names or moved within the same precincts, their registration serves as proof of residence
NOTICE OF LATE REGISTRATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A voter can provide a Notice of Late Registration from the County as proof of residence
STAFF PERSON OF A RESIDENTIAL FACILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a voter lives in a residential facility a staff person from the facility can vouch for their residency. The staff person must either appear on a list of employees provided to Judges with election supplies or provide an employee badge to demonstrate their employment.
