Early Literacy Tip of the Week:

Singing is important for language development. Many of us cannot sing on key. Don't let that stop you! Singing slows down language and there is often a different note for each syllable. Both of these help children hear the smaller sounds in words. This will later help them sound out words as they learn to read.
