






Read Write Sing Talk Play

Welcome Songs:

If you're ready for a story
clap your hands!

(Nod your head, sit so still,
etc.)

Activity/Flannel Board:

One little, two little, three little umbrellas
Four little, five little, six little umbrellas
Seven little, eight little, nine little umbrellas
Ten umbrellas up for the rain

*Repeat with raindrops going on top of umbrellas –
last line, "Ten raindrops falling down." Pull raindrops
away, counting down – last line, "No raindrops out
today." Pull umbrellas away, counting down – last
line, "Everything's put away!"*
