

CLOSING POLICY

The pool will close...

- When the outdoor temperature falls **below 65 degrees Fahrenheit.**
- When lightning is sighted or the weather is threatening.



- When the pool closes for weather, staff will re-assess conditions at two hour intervals and if weather permits, the pool will re-open. Please check at 3:00, 5:00 and 7:00 p.m.
- Pool may close for the remainder of a scheduled open swim when there are fewer than 15 people in the pool.
- Pool may close when there is need for maintenance or emergency action or repairs.
- Contact the Rec Hotline at 934-0070 for weather related closures.

- Children ages 0—6 must have and adult or responsible supervisor (**age 15 or older**) in the water and within arms reach of the child at all times with or without an approved lifejacket.
- Children younger than 5 may enter the main pool free of charge when accompanied by a paying supervisor **age 15 or older**.

FAMILY FRIENDLY POOL PASS

Family Pool Pass **only \$35** for up to 6 family members. Additional family members may be added at a cost of \$5/ person. Add babysitters or nannies to your pass for only \$20 more. Expires Sept. 1, 2014.

PRIVATE RENTALS

Available for private rentals Mon—Fri from 8:15-10:15 p.m.; Sat/Sun from 9—12 a.m. Food and beverage can be served in the concession area inside the pool. Reservations must be made at least one week in advance by contacting the Outdoor Pool Manager at the pool or by phone at 934-3951.

FEES

Open Swim & Family Swim

\$2.50 per time for ages 5 and up.

Children must be 7 years old in order to be admitted to the main pool without an adult or a responsible supervisor.

*Ages 0—6 must have an adult or supervisor (**age 15 or older**) in the water and within arms reach of the child at all times with or without an approved lifejacket.*

*FREE for ages 0—4 when accompanied by a paying adult or responsible supervisor **age 15 or older**.*
