The City of Saint Peter will be trimming boulevard trees throughout the city during the winter months. **Please remember to take holiday lights off all boulevard trees.**



SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS:



Snow and ice are required to be removed by the property owner and/or tenant within twenty-four (24) hours after a snowfall ends. The City will inspect the sidewalks after the 24-hour period and will remove the snow and ice immediately upon discovery. The cost of the removal will be billed to the homeowner based on the labor and equipment fees established for such work, which is \$75.00 per hour (minimum charge is \$75.00).

Please make arrangements for snow and ice removal from sidewalks including corners and/or handicapped ramps.

Automatic Utility Payments are FREE and CONVENIENT. Save time and money, never pay a late fee or postage

The City of Saint Peter offers FREE automatic bank payment from any bank. You would still receive your utility bill at the same time each month. Across the top it would be noted - ***DO NO PAY* PAID BY DRAFT**. Your payment would then be deducted from your checking or savings account on the due date each month (usually the 15th).
