CITY COUNCIL MEETING – The City Council meeting of September 13, 2021 included action to call for a public hearing in October on creation of a housing Tax Increment Financing District No. 1-24; adoption of the preliminary tax levy for 2021 (payable 2022); approval of a request to subordinate a mortgage for River Rock Kitchen and Bakery to a new bank line of credit; approval of a revolving loan request for Malin Halal Meat and Grocery Store; approval of a revolving loan Request for MNO Real Estate, LLC for a project to establish a boutique hotel; approval for City assistance for Oktoberfest event; award of bid for the 2021 Equipment Certificates; and adoption of a construction standard detail plate for curb cut and right-of-way line driveways for single family homes with three stall garages.

The next regular City Council meeting will be Monday, September 27, 2021 beginning at 7:00 p.m. As a reminder, Council meetings are once again back to in-person only. No virtual participation will be available.
