If your scheduled pick up day falls on the following observed holidays, your pick up day will be moved out by 1 day for the remainder of that week. **If observed holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no change in pickup.**

Example for a Holiday Week with Labor Day on Monday, Sept 5th, 2022

Monday normal pickups will be Tuesday Sep. 6th.
Tuesday normal pickups will be Wed Sep. 7th
Wednesday normal pickups will be Thurs Sep. 8th

We will be providing the curbside collection of Waste and Single Sort Recycling like you have received for the past 5 years. We have provided a cart with a yellow lid for recycling and a cart with a black lid for trash. Trash is collected weekly on your collection day. Recycling is collected every other week on your collection day. Those residents with qualified disabilities which present a hardship with getting trash and recyclables curbside will be provided with walk-up service. Please call the City of Saint Peter to arrange this service.

Guide To Single Stream Recycling

- Aluminum & Metal Food & Beverage Containers
- #1, 2, 4 & 5 Plastic Food & Beverage Containers
- Newspapers, Junk mail & Greeting Cards
- Food & Beverage Glass Bottles & Jars

- Paperboard Boxes
- Please flatten all cardboard boxes
- Empty & rinse all containers

NO:

- Plastic Bags, wrap or films
- Styrofoam packaging, containers or cups
- Ceramics, pyrex, dishes or drinking glasses
- Auto or window glass, mirrors or light bulbs
- Wallpaper, gift paper, tissue paper or sticker release paper, wrapping paper
- Coffee filters, tea bags
- Candy/gum wrappers, plastic 6 or 4 pack holders
- Oil, antifreeze or fuel containers
- Photos, transparencies or slides
- Razors, needles or sharps

NO:

- Yard waste, weeds or brush
- Pillow envelopes
- Packing peanuts
- Lawn chairs or furniture
- Flower pots
- Carpet
- Clothing or blankets
- Wood
- Shredded Paper
- Do not place in plastic bags - paper bags are okay
- Holiday lights, extension cords
- Batteries of any kind
- Egg cartons, milk cartons, and roll tubes
- Pizza delivery boxes
- Plastic clam shell food containers

- Monday** West side of Washington Ave. & North/South side of Skaro St.
- Tuesday** West side of Washington Ave. South side of Skaro St. to North side of College Ave. East side of Washington Ave. & South side of Sumner St. South side of Union St. to North side of College Ave.
- Wednesday** South side of College Ave. Summit Mobile Home Park

COLLECTION POINT

All residential trash & recyclables must be placed streetside by 7:00 a.m.

Trash & recyclables should be placed at the end of your driveway or along your boulevard.

DO NOT place your containers on the street.

Please keep the recycling cart & trash cart at least three feet apart.

Unacceptable Items In Your Trash

No paints, liquids, chemicals, motor oil or filters, car batteries, tires, fluorescent light bulbs or yardwaste may be placed in your residential trash.
